1945 and 2019 Hudson Valley Expositions: Then and Now

In August of 1945, in an effort to stimulate the local economy after the War, the then-named Peekskill Chamber of Commerce presented the Hudson Valley Exposition for the first time.

Originally held over three days at the Peekskill Stadium on Welcher Avenue (now where Peekskill Green Grocers is located), the Exposition was an illustration of the dynamic local economy and the booming future that lay ahead as World War II veterans returned looking to start a life and a family. Consumer demand spurred the economy.

The entertainment included dog acts, musicians, and horse and rodeo performances. Exhibits included household appliances, technology advancements and the new 1946 Buick. In many respects, the Exposition served as a mini-World's Fair of sorts with its "World of Tomorrow" Exhibit.

Local businesses were ready, too, for the consumers who wanted to get back to a normal life after the war. On display at the Exposition was Furniture by Tomlinson presented by J.J. Dorsey Inc., Seiberling Tires' new thermo-weld system sold at Lazar's,



and "Woodco" window units and Gold Bond wall board by N. Dain's Sons Co. at 100 Water St—who are still at their family's location today. In fact, Dain's will be on hand doing saw mill demonstrations at this year's Exposition as they were last year.

Belmont Motors displayed two 1946 Ford Cars that were sold at a discount to veterans coming home from the war and Schulte-United took free pictures of all the children who attended the Exposition. the Girl Scouts offered child care.

The "Made in Peekskill" exhibits included Hy-Art Novelty Co. (display hooked rugs), French Veiling Corp. (the latest in hairnets), Charm Undergarments (feature newly-designed slips), Ednal Co. (lens and prisms) and

Standard Brands (food products).

Fast forward 60 years: with a lagging economy, during the 2015 Hudson Valley Gateway Chamber of Commerce 100th Anniversary celebration, the Exposition was re-introduced by the chamber to a whole new wave of residents.

"We wanted to showcase everything that makes the Hudson Valley so special—food, art, music, businesses, history and more. The best part is that we can feature everything against the backdrop of the majestic Hudson River—it doesn't get any better than that," said President of the Hudson Valley Chamber of Commerce, Deb Milone.

The Exposition promotes the benefits and bounty of living, working and playing in the Hudson Valley with a focus on art, music, trendy businesses, holistic/wellness, and energy and technology along with the best of the Hudson Valley's food, craft beer and wines.

All in all, the 1945 The Hudson Valley Exposition proved to be a rousing success and ran for seven years. The 21st Century version is now in its fourth year, and chamber organizers hope the event runs for many more.

Jimi Hendrix 'Re-Experience' Band to Rock Stage at Expo

ifty years after participating in the Woodstock music festival that shaped a generation, a living piece of music history looks to pay tribute to the nowiconic gathering.

Juma Sultan, a musician who played with Jimi Hendrix at Woodstock in 1969, will be making an appearance at the Hudson Valley Exposition alongside Kiss The Sky, a group known as a Jimi Hendrix "re-experience" rather than just a cover band. Led by guitarist Jimy Bleu, Kiss The Sky takes a revolving stable of recording artists from the New York metropolitan area and brings them together to capture every essence of the original Hendrix spirit.

Not content to just play the same songs that made Jimi Hendrix a household name, the band is often deckedout in similar or replica clothes that the original band would have worn, and plays with identical instruments with similar amplifying effects to truly recreate the original sound. Bleu even trained himself to play guitar left-handed, behind his back, and with his teeth, all of which were signature Hendrix moves.

"To me, this is one of the most truth-



ful versions of Jimi's music I've seen," Sultan said in an interview. "I've played with 'cover bands' who are good, but he [Bleu] is different. He is very charismatic and brings an original character to the music."


Sultan, a member of the Blues Hall of Fame, has been playing music since

the early 1960's, when he started out primarily as a jazz musician playing the upright bass. After moving from his hometown of Monrovia, California, to New York City, he was fortunate enough to become acquaintances with Hendrix, as well as a slew of other talented musicians. After collaborating several times and strengthening their friendship, Sultan was invited to be a part of Hendrix's Gypsy Sun and Rainbows band, now playing percussion instruments.

Over the years Sultan has toured with other former members of Hendrix's band (each of them also having performed with Kiss The Sky), and is looking forward to performing for a large music festival called WE2019 in North Carolina in August. WE2019 is a two-weekend festival looking to recreate the magic from the original Woodstock concert, featuring eight artists who performed at the last concert 50 years ago.

"It can never be repeated or duplicated," Sultan said, talking about his experience at the Woodstock concert. "I experienced unity, brotherhood, and love, and that's something that's hard to bring out today. The spirit that prevailed there still lives, but it's dormant [now]."

The Hudson Valley Exposition takes place on Saturday, August 3, from 1 to 10 p.m. at Riverfront Green Park in Peekskill. The "Rockin' the Green" concert, celebrating the 50th Anniversary of the Woodstock concert, begins at 4 p.m. on the main stage. Visit www. hvexposition.com for more details.






