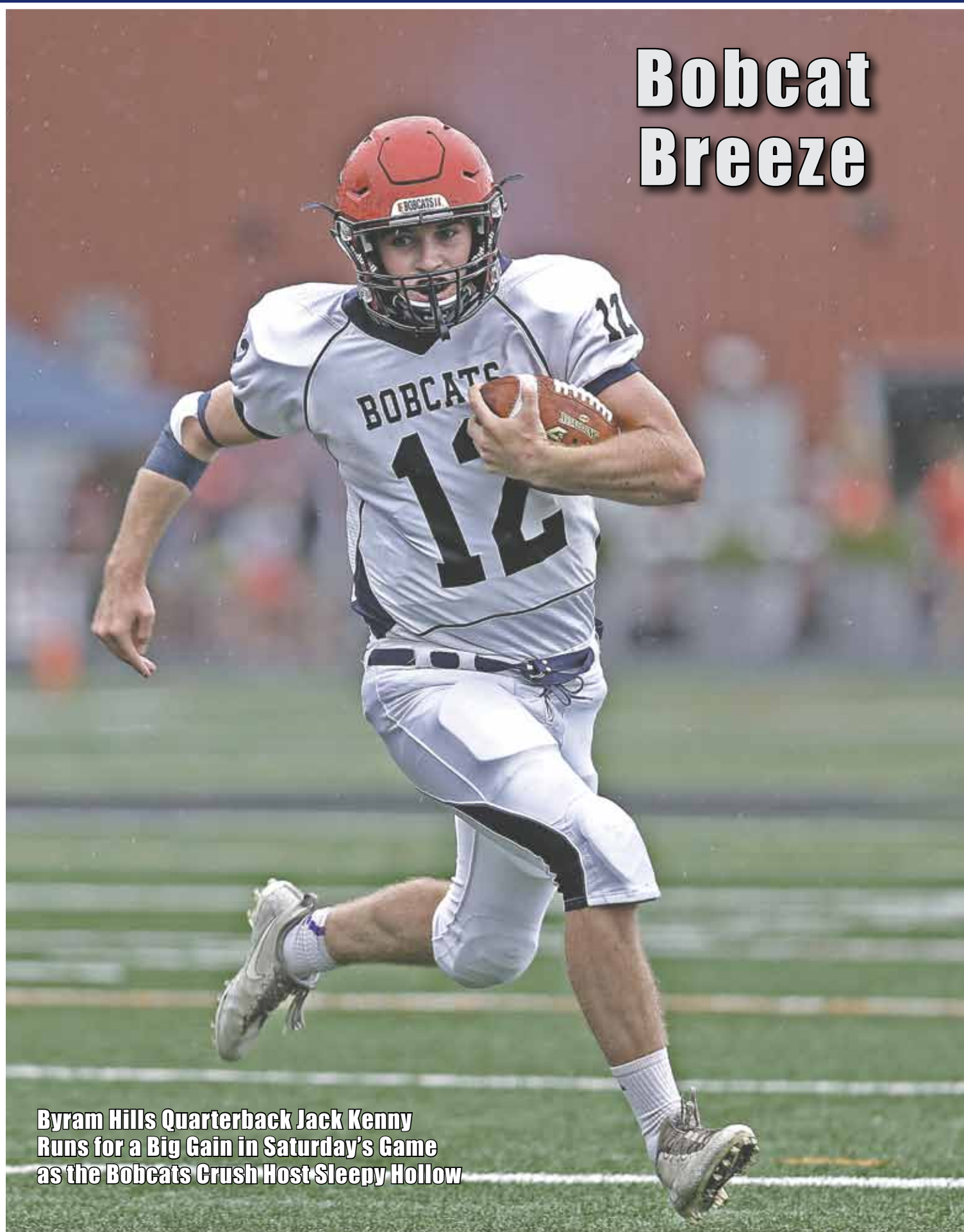

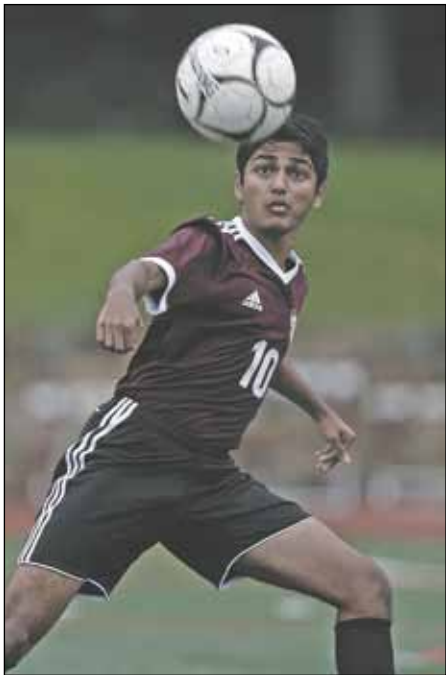

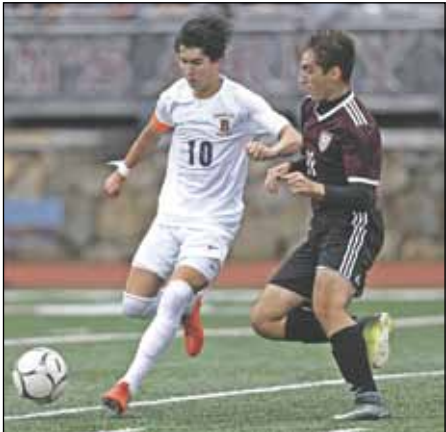

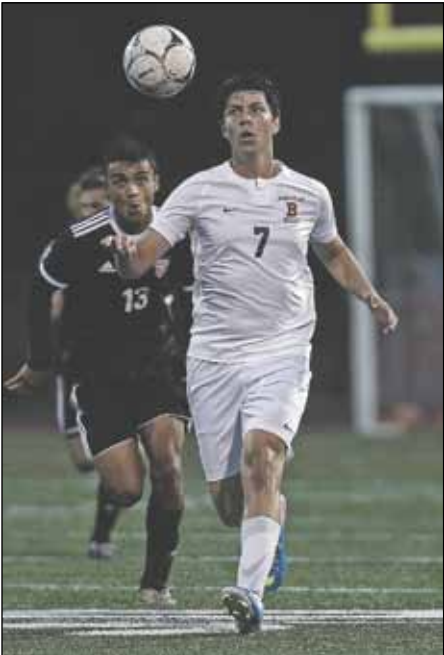

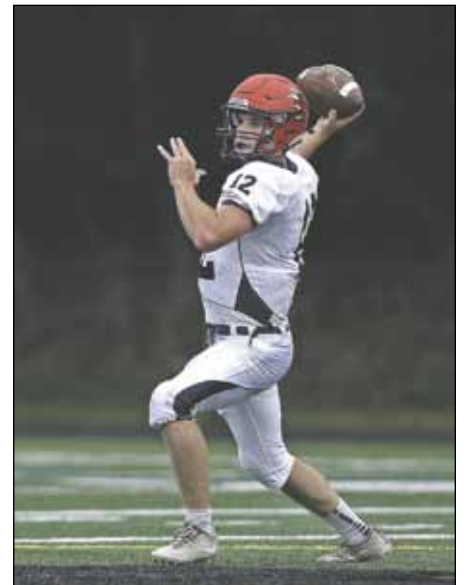
Byram Hills Cruises to a Road Victory over Sleepy Hollow

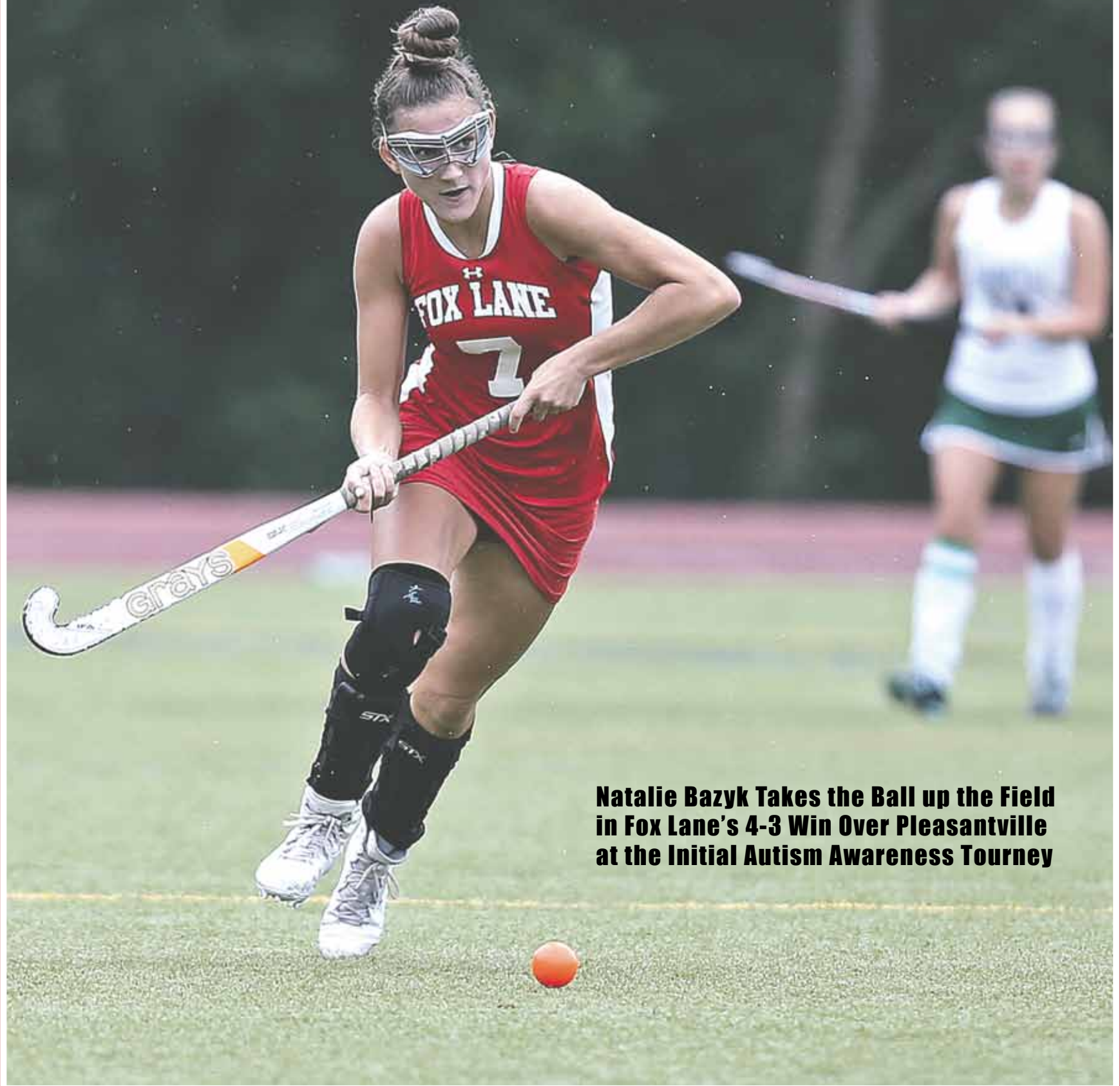
