


#### Letter from Superintendent Dr. Joel Adelberg

read or listen to.


However, even in our digital age, the lack of contact with other people fuels boredom. Social media and video calls don't fill the void in our hearts because humans are inherently social creatures.

Maybe you will finally find that one hobby that clicks or you'll remember a project you never had time for. During the


